- 10mm, 15mm (deep) Socket
- 5mm Allen Bit
- Box cutter/ Knife
- Trim Clip Tool
- WD-40 (Optional)
- Flathead Screwdriver/Small Pry Bar

SKILL LEVEL

- Intermediate
- -1 (you) to 2 persons

Intermediate skill level required, you can install it by yourself however, additional help is recommended.

TIME REQUIRED

- 2 Hours

Time to install this should only take about two hours.




STEP 1 | Peel back the paper from the water-resistant film and apply it to the bottom of the mount with mounting holes.

Place it carefully and evenly to avoid creating bubbles.

If mounting a compressor, you will cut through this at the mounting holes later.













 $\begin{array}{c|c} \text{STEP 2} & \text{Peel back the paper from} \\ \text{the heat shield and install it on the} \end{array}$ mount. The opening in the shield material will go over the mounting holes on the compressor side of the mount.





 $\begin{array}{c|c} \textbf{STEP 3} & \textbf{I} & \textbf{Install drain caps to both} \\ \textbf{sides of the compressor mount.} \end{array}$

You may choose to skip the drain cap on the compressor side if you do not want to press a hole out of the waterproof membrane.










STEP 4 | Use a trim clip tool to remove the plastic covers from the tiedown hooks.

The number of tie-downs varies between 4-door models and 2-door models.





STEP 5 Use a 10mm socket to remove the hardware securing the factory tie-downs to the vehicle.










STEP 6 | Lift and fold the carpet forward to access the hardware securing the factory storage box to the vehicle.



STEP 7 Use a 10mm socket to remove the hardware securing the factory storage box to the vehicle.










STEP 8 | Use a 15mm deep socket to loosen the clamp securing the muffler to the exhaust tube.











STEP 9 | Remove the muffler from the exhaust hangers.

One is located next to the hitch, and the other is located between the muffler and driverside rear tire.

These may require some force to remove. Use WD-40 and a pry tool if necessary.











 $\begin{array}{c|c} \text{STEP 10} & \text{Remove the muffler by} \\ \text{pulling it from the exhaust tube towards} \\ \text{the rear of the vehicle.} \end{array}$





STEP 11 Use a 10mm socket and a trim clip tool to remove the factory hardware and plastic clip retainers securing the factory heat shield in place.

Then remove the factory heat shield.







STEP 12 | Use a 10mm socket to install the mounting plate using the factory hardware and mounting locations.



STEP 13 | Place the DV8 storage box under the vehicle and lift it to the mounting plate by reaching down through the empty space in the cab.

Loosely secure the box to the mounting plate using the provided M8 hardware.

NOTE: This step is easier with assistance.











STEP 14 | Secure the provided M8 hardware using a 5mm allen bit.



STEP 15 | If you are mounting a compressor, do so at this time using the hardware provided with the compressor.

Our compressor mount is designed for single or twin tube ARB air compressors.










STEP 16 | We provide multiple grommets for different wiring applications.

The pre-installed flat grommet is for the ARB style harness, and can be used by cutting a slit open in one direction.

Remove the grommet to cut it, then push the harness through and re-install.

We also provided an accordion style grommet for a more universal solution to different applications.















STEP 17 | Re-install the muffler onto the exhaust tube by pressing it into place.



STEP 18 | Finish securing the muffler by re-installing it onto the hangers.









STEP 19 | Secure the clamp on the exhaust using a 15mm deep socket.



STEP 20 | Install the factory tiedowns using a 10mm socket and the factory hardware.









 $\begin{array}{c|c} \text{STEP 21} & \text{Install the factory tie-down} \\ \text{covers by pressing them into place}. \end{array}$

Then, flip the carpet closed.





STEP 22 | Congrats! You are finished with the install of the 21+ Ford Bronco Hidden Air Compressor Mount
