TOOLS REQUIRED

-Zip ties

- -Trim Remover Tool
- -10, 18mm sockets/wrenches
- -#4 Allen head
- -Snips/flathead screwdriver (optional)

SKILL LEVEL

- Novice/Intermediate

-1 (you) to 2 persons

Little skill level required, you can easily install it by yourself however, additional help will be useful

TIME REQUIRED

- 3.5 Hours

Time to install this should only take about an three and a half hours.

Begin by unpacking all items and inspecting for missing pieces or damage. If you have any concerns, please contact the company the product was purchased from. Extra hardware may be included with the product.

- (4) M12x35mm Bolts
 (4) M12 Flat Washers
 (4) M6x20mm Bolts
 (4) M6 Lock Washers
 (8) M6 Flat Washers
- (4) M12 Flat Nuts(4) M12 Lock Washers



STEP 1 | To being removing the bumper, unplug all wiring to the sensors, lights and tow plug.

Start by removing the railer plug wiring connector.



STEP 2 Above the exhaust (on a dual exhaust vehicle) remove the large connector for the rear bumper. This is held on by a push pin. Flip up the latch, and the plug should disconnect itself.










STEP 3 Disconnect the wiring from frame releasing a trim clip tool so that the wiring is free.



STEP 4 Remove the license plate to expose the two 15mm bolts. Using a 15mm socket, remove the bolts.

Using a trim tool, remove the two push pins.









STEP 5 Using a 16mm socket or wrench, remove the (4) nuts (2 per side) to release the bumper.

Please Note: Once nuts are removed, bumper will be loose. Use caution to prevent injury or damage to truck/bumper.



STEP 6 Once bumper is removed, place on soft surface to prevent damage. Begin by removing your wire harness from the bumper.

Using a push pin tool, release all the push pins located along the backside of the bumper.










STEP 7 Once the wire harness if free from the bumper, disconnect the two license plate lights by depressing the tab on the plug and pulling away from the light.




STEP 8 Next, remove the sensors (if equipped). Do not unplug the sensors, rather, gently spread the two clips on each side of the sensor and pull the sensor back away from the bumper.

The wire harness should be free and set aside.










STEP 9 Remove the trailer plug. Using a flat head or trim clip tool, press in both sides of the metal retaining clip and push the plug out towards the front of the bumper.







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STEP 10 Using a 10mm socket or wrench, remove both license plate lights from the bumper.





STEP 11 Begin by feeding the wiring harness through the cavities of the bumper until sensors and light plugs align with their new holes.

Do not run wiring over the mounting holes (green arrow).





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STEP 12 | Install the factory license plate lights by feeding them through the face of the bumper. Using the factory bolt and a 10mm socket/wrench, secure light.

Plug light into harness.





STEP 13 |

Continue feeding the harness into place. If truck is equipped with sensors, remove the factory bezels (some trim models). Place factory bezels into corresponding holes onto new bumper. Push in sensors from the backside until they click into place.

If bumper is not equipped with removable factory sensor bezels, use DV8 part# MPRSNSR-01.











STEP 14 | Install trailer wiring plug from the front side of the bumper until it snaps into place. Connect to harness.

If harness has a small flat sensor (key remote sensor) located on the center of the factory bumper, using the provided 3M tape, apply it on the flat area on the backside of the license plate mount.









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STEP 15 | Secure wiring to bumper using the built-in zip tie tabs.



STEP 16 | Take the M12 flat nuts, and slide them in place over the bumper mounting holes.



STEP 17 | If the vehicle is equipped with dual exit exhaust, remove the two lower panels using a 10mm and #4 Allen bit.








STEP 18 | If running pod lights, install them now.

We are using (2) 3" DV8 Elite pod lights.



STEP 19 | With assistance to prevent injury or damage to the vehicle, lift the bumper to the truck and using the provided M12 hardware (bolt, flat washer and spring washer), loosely secure the bumper to the vehicle.









STEP 20 | Adjust the bumper side to side and up and down. Once in the desired location, using a 18mm socket, secure hardware.



STEP 21 | Slowly open tailgate to ensure it clears the bumper and does not make contact.



STEP 22 | Plug in the harness into the factory plugs that were removed in steps 1 & 2.







STEP 23 Double check all hardware is secure and all plugs are properly connected.
