INSTALLATION MANUAL

Light Bar Bracket

2021+ Bronco LBBR-03



TOOLS REQUIRED

- 10mm Socket

SKILL LEVEL

- Novice/Intermediate - 1 (you) to 2 persons

Little skill level required, you can easily install it by yourself however, additional help will be useful.

TIME REQUIRED

-1Hour

Time to install this should only take about an hour

STEP 1


Begin by unpacking all items and inspecting for missing pieces or damage. If you have any concerns, please contact the company the product was purchased from.



STEP 2

Remove the factory accessory mount cover over the windshield by pressing the center of the top and pulling away from the Bronco.







STEP 3

Remove the black plastic structure using a 10mm socket. Keep nuts close since they will be reused.

NOTE: Refer to manual to access factory light bar wiring if bronco is equipped with auxiliary switch option.





STEP 4

Our curved light bar can accept a 42" (mount to mount) curved light, or twelve 3" pods. Mount the light(s) using hardware provided with the light(s).

Some light manufacturers include hardware that is long enough to interfere with the factory windshield wipers. Shorter hardware will need to be sourced locally to remedy this issue.

Note: Shown in image is the 42" wide curved bar. We are using twelve 3" DV8 elite pods for our install.





STEP 5

Hold the mount up to the vehicle and place onto accessory mount posts.

NOTE: While this can be done alone, we do recommend assistance to prevent any injury or damage to the vehicle.



STEP 6

Using the 10mm factory nuts, tighten mount into place until secure. Do not over tighten posts to prevent damage to threads.



STEP 7

Wiring for your light may vary depending on if the wire is directed towards the driver or passenger side of the Bronco. For this install, the wiring was on the passenger side. The wiring was affixed along of the bracket mount towards the back of the Bronco. Feed wiring as preferred or utilize factory provided wiring if applicable.





STEP 8

Double check all hardware is secure and secure wiring as needed.
