TOOLS REQUIRED

- 10mm, 16mm wrench
- 7mm, 10mm, 14mm, 21mm, socket
- Flat head screwdriver
- Trim Tool
- Safety Glasses

SKILL LEVEL

- Novice/Intermediate

-1 (you) to 2 persons

Little skill level required, you can easily install it by yourself however, additional help will be useful

TIME REQUIRED

- 3 Hours

Time to install this should take about 3 hours.


(4) M10x30mm Hex Bolts(4) M10 Spring Washers(4) M10 Flat Washers(4) M10 Clip Nuts

(4) M6x20mm Allen Head bolts(8) M6 Washers(4) M6 Lock Nuts



STEP 1 | To remove the bumperbeing by removing the license plate. Unplug the license plate light wiring harness.

Unplug the trailer plug connector from underneath the vehicle.








STEP 2 | Disconnect the main wiring harness. Use a trim tool to unclip the wiring harness push pin from the frame.


Remove the license plate light. Grab the light/plug and rotate left to remove.





STEP 3 Using a 21mm socket or wrench remove factory bolts on both sides of the bumper (2 per side). These will be tough due to faxctory thread locker used.

Note: Assistance is recommend to prevent bumper from falling and injury or damage to the vehicle.










STEP 4 | Once bumper is removed, place on soft surface to prevent damage.

Begin by removing the trailer plug. Use a flat head or trim clip tool press in on both sides of the metal retaining clip and push the plug out toward the front of the bumper.



STEP 5 Using a 7mm socket or wrench, remove both license plate lights from the bumper.











STEP 7 | Install trailer wiring connector into the DV8 bumper by pressing the connector through the front side of the bumper until it snaps into place



STEP 8 | Use a 10mm wrench, #4 Allen tool and the provided M6 hardware to secure the license plate light housing in place.



STEP 9 | Reinstall the license plate lights in to the light housings.

Use zip ties to secure any loose wiring harness to the bumper.









STEP 10 | If running pod lights, install them now.

For this install we are using (2) 3" DV8 Elite pod lights.



STEP 11 | Install the provided M10 clip nuts onto the bumper mounting brackets.







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STEP 12 | Place the frame mounting bracket on the bumper, use the provided M10 Hex bolts to loosely secure bracket in place.

Use 1 split washer and 1 flat washer per bolt.




STEP 13 | With the license plate lights, trailer connector and frame brackets installed on the bumper it is ready to be mounted on the vehicle.



STEP 14 | With assistance lift the bumper in place and loosely secure the bumper using the factory frame bolts previously removed in step 3 and a 21mm socket.

Adjust the bumper side to side and up and down to center the bumper. Ensure the tailgate does not impact the bumper when opening and closing the tailgate.







STEP 15 | Secure the factory hardware using a 21mm socket or wrench secure factory bolts on both sides of the bumper (2 per side)



STEP 16 | Using a 16mm wrench secure hardware on the bumper mounting brackets.









STEP 17 | Plug in the license plate and trailer harness into the factory plugs that were removed in steps 1 & 2.





STEP 18 | Double check all hardware is secure and all plugs are properly connect.
