STEP 1 | Roll down your windows prior to disconnecting the wiring.

This will make lifting the doors off easier and protect the glass form damage.


Remove the trim panel by pulling towards the rear of the vehicle until it unclips.

Remove the wire connector by rotating the white clip until the connector is no longer locked, and then pull free.










STEP 2 | Now that the wiring harness has been disconnected, lift on the door strap to remove it from the hook.

Using a T40 torx bit, remoeve the door check.

Note: Take caution not to damage the vehicle as the doors may swing towards the front fender.







STEP 3 Use a T50 torx bit to remove the bolts securing the doors to the vehicle. With the assistance of another person, lift the door carefully off the vehicle and set off to the side, being careful not to damage the door or vehicle.









Begin by unpacking all items and inspecting for missing pieces or damage. If you have any concerns, please contact the company the product was purchased from. Extra hardware may be included with the product.

STEP 4 | Place the foot pegs onto the factory door hinge.

Note: If these installed on a 07-18 Wrangler JK, nylon shims are provided to be placed between the door hinge and foot peg on the top and bottom of the hinge.












STEP 5 | Installed the provided M10 hardware and secure with a a #6 allen bit and 17mm socket.

Hardware should be tight enough to ensure the foot pegs do not shift during everyday driving, but can be adjusted inwards and outwards if desired.
